# **Burris Tire Recommendations**

### Cold Weather

- Flexing, crushing and/or folding Burris tires in cold conditions (below 32° F) should be avoided.
- In cold conditions, Burris tires should be warmed to room temperature (approximately 70° F) for several hours before mounting, flexing or unfolding/folding to avoid damage/cracking of the rubber

### • Long Term Tire Storage Recommendations

- o Burris Tires should be stored in moderate temperatures when not in use
- Avoid storing tires in trailers over extended periods of time where there will be extreme temperatures (hot or cold)
- Store in plastic garbage bags or wrap in plastic wrap to minimize exposure to oxygen
- Keep away from electric motors and power panels

#### <u>Directional Mounting</u>

o Burris tires are not directional and can be mounted with either side out

## Tire Mounting

Tire mounting should be done <u>only</u> by experienced trained personnel using the proper tools and procedures. Failure to follow safe mounting procedures can cause the tire and/or wheel to burst with forces sufficient to cause **SERIOUS PERSONAL INJURY OR DEATH**. Always inspect the tire for possible damage that may have occurred during shipping or storage. Clean the rim and lubricate beads with rubber lubricant. Use a clip on chuck with an in-line valve and pressure gauge or adjustable regulator and remote inflation/deflation device. Have enough air hose to create a safe distance.
